## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

### Electrochemical Plant JSC

Electrochemical Plant, Joint-Stock Company (hereinafter referred to as Electrochemical Plant JSC) is an enterprise of ROSATOM State Atomic Energy Corporation and a structural unit of TVEL JSC. One of the largest manufacturers of enriched uranium, isotopes, hydrofluoric acid and anhydrous hydrogen.

The management of Electrochemical Plant JSC acknowledges that business operations of the enterprise related to nuclear power, the handling of nuclear materials, radioactive substances and radioactive waste must not adversely affect the environment and human health.
